President's Message 20-05-14

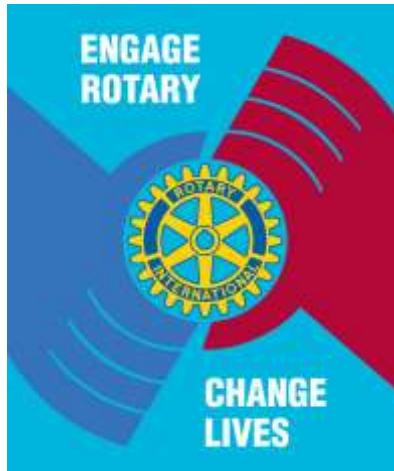
