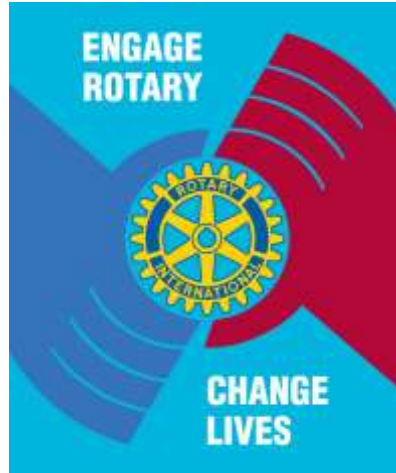
President's Message 17-06-14
