Past President's Message 1-07-14

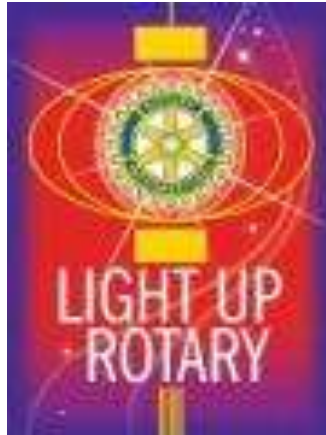
