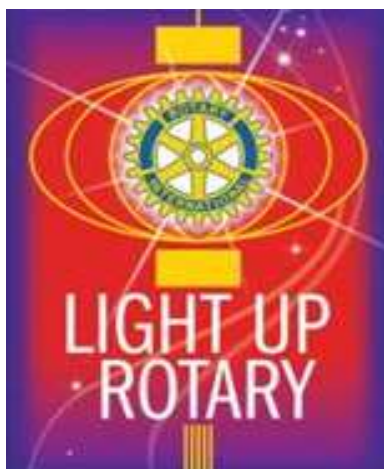
Amanda has joined the Club committee and will work with Geoff on membership.
