Those of you present were able to take one of their very impressive booklets and Annual report.

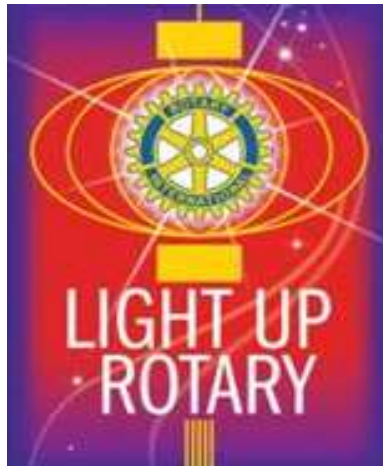
Our exchange student, Liz Holtz has arrived safely and is now with the Hennesys, her first host family. We look forward to seeing Liz at a Club meeting soon.
