President's Message 26-08-14

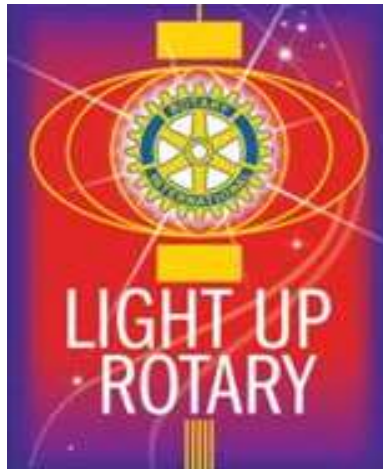
