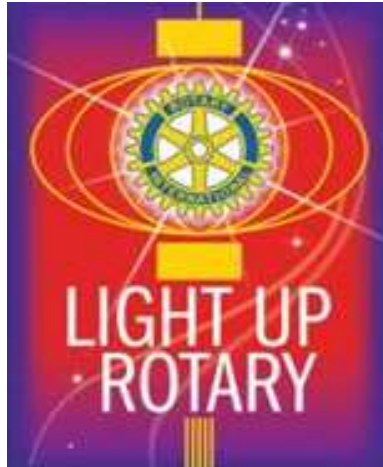
## President's Message
