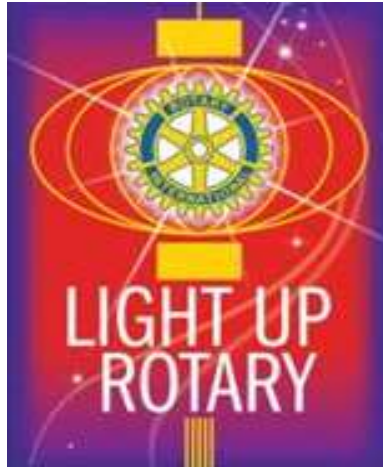
The warehouse continues to bring in substantial income. The average sales to date this financial year is around \$ 960 per day!
