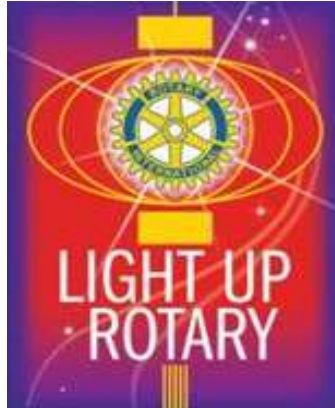

## **President's Message**

We had another strong speaker at last week's meeting - Jan Pearman - from Rosebud Secondary College. She spoke about vocational and career guidance and about the importance of students having one week's work experience in the area they are interested in.

She gave us some great insights into the amount of work that secondary school vocation teachers put in to give every student the opportunity of exploring and finding their best career options.

She gave a breakdown of statistics on year 12 students as to what career paths they follow and the percentage that go to university.

Jan highlighted the geographical barrier that many students from this area face in attending universities in Melbourne. Only some are able to afford accommodation closer to their campus. She said many have to spend up to six hours a day commuting to and from their classes.

This coming Wednesday morning there will be a special business breakfast as Sommerville Tyabb Rotary. Starting time is 7.15am sharp. 'Business tips in difficult times' will be the topic by speaker David Chalke – one of Australia's leading social analysts and principal of The Strategy Planning Group.

Cost is \$10 a head and it should be well worth attending.
