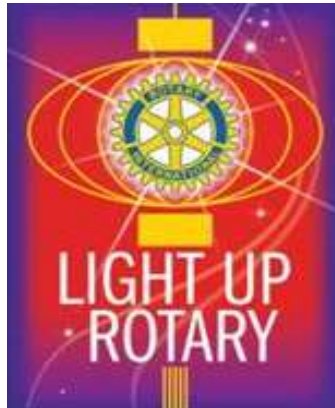

Last week we had a business meeting and in Brian's absence I handed out to all the members present the Profit and Loss summaries from July to December - the first half of the financial year.

The Warehouse income after expenses is up nearly \$8K over budget which is a great result. The Op Shop which is also showing nearly a third increase over budget after expenses.

Club members agreed to give them a donation equivalent to one month's rent which would give them a breather while your board assesses whether we can help them and secure some support. John Adamson gave a short testimony on the attributes of Nick's work at the club.

This was followed by Steph, a lady from The Salvation Army, who offered young people a six to eight week course called Tools For The Trade. She spoke about the great need for this type of youth club.

What I liked were the simple rules; No Alcohol. No Drugs. No Smoking. No Bullying.

We have our second Breakfast meeting on the 17th February again at the Blue Mini Café on Colchester Road. At this stage we look like having a bigger number of businesses attending which would be a terrific result. So members please support this initiative and try to bring along two business people you know.

On Australia Day at Rye we had a strong contingent of Rotary volunteers to run the food van and support local people with food and coffee. A special thanks to all the volunteers especially Barry Irving for organizing such a successful day
