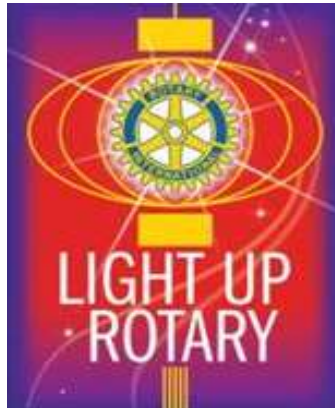

Our guest speaker on Tuesday night was Kim Michod, the public relations person for Peninsula Home Hospice. She talked about the great work they do with our sick and elderly on the Peninsula. At any one time they have between 120 -130 patients and this program is all run by volunteers.

Last year they provided palliative care of over 1200 people. The idea is that these people enjoy the remaining months of their lives in their home. The great thing is it doesn't cost them or their families a cent as there is no fees charged for the service.

This is a wonderful not for profit organisation and is about 75% government funded. They are always striving to raise extra money to fill that 25% shortfall.

Our meeting was followed by our monthly board meeting and a summary of the decisions made by the board will be provided in a separate report. One thing the board has agreed on is to partially fund and support Rychelle Vines' program for Cross Country Education on the Peninsula.

This coming meeting I have invited Nick, the youth worker from the Fight for Life Youth Club to come along and speak to members and give a short presentation on what he does and why Rotary should support this club.

It is on the brink of closure due to lack of funding and good management.

At our meeting this week there will be a report from the board and the opportunity for members to ask questions and provide input.

I hope everyone had a happy Australia Day.
