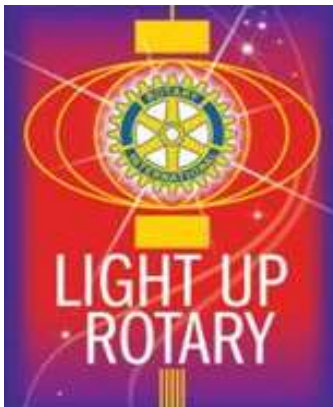

What a week and a milestone for the Rosebud-Rye Rotary Club with so many things on. The meeting on Tuesday night was busy and we covered the business side of the Club's fundraising activities and Brian presented accurate figures showing we are on target or above budget from our main fundraising enterprises. We are close to full allocation of donations including our \$50,000 pledge to the Rosebud Secondary College Empowerment Centre. Our Rotary Governor, Charlie Speirs, came along as well as a visiting Rotarian from a club in Cambodia and our exchange student Lyz Holz. Members of the board were very interested to hear Governor Charlie's input on how the Club can secure District and International grants. This is very important for the club to try and secure some of these funds as there is certainly money available.

On Thursday night a number of past and present Rotarians from Rosebud-Rye attended the highly organised and completely sold out, showing in Frankston of 'The Second Best Exotic Marigold Hotel'. This was a big event for Rotary and a major fundraiser for 'Polio Plus' with many clubs across Australia holding similar events.

Friday night saw the first committee meeting for the year for the Fight 4 Life Youth Club. This was held at their club premises and saw three new members appointed to their board and a plan discussed for fundraising and financial support for the coming twelve months. This club needs strong support from all areas in the community and needs to be proactive and have a strong guiding body so if you can help in some way.

Saturday was 'sale day' for Rotary House with the auction set to start at 12.30. There was great interest and although off to a slow start soon gathered momentum and under the careful guidance of Steve Depler the premises was sold for \$471,000. This was a great result and a delight to see the buyer, agent and the vendor all very pleased with themselves. A special thanks to everyone who helped with the sale preparation as in supplying permits, title forms and other required papers.
