Victoria Police Leaders Mentoring Program (VPLMP)

The Rotary Club of Rosebud-Rye has been invited to provide mentorship to a member of the local police force under the VPLMP.

The VPLMP is a partnership between Victoria Police, Rotary International and the Victorian Business Community, which provides opportunities to police members who are considered to be leaders within their field and have potential for more senior roles in the future.

The aim of the program is to develop the understanding and capability of mentees in:

- Effective community engagement mechanisms and approaches
- Strategic community partnerships, managing stakeholder relationships and building networks
- Community organizational approaches to addressing community issues and needs
- The community service environment and the inter-relationship between Police and community groups
- Applying business management skills to community service planning and delivery

Information about expectations of Rosebud-Rye Rotary, and discussion about how we will provide appropriate and relevant experience, will be discussed in the next couple of weeks.
