Claire was the first **Four Minutes of Fame** presenter for the year and led off by giving us an overview of the 4 Fish Principles which are: Play, Make their Day, Be Present and Choose your Attitude.

Play ~ Work made fun gets done! Play is about your state of mind. Be creative in problem solving. Play energises you and the people around you. Any job can be boring if you make it boring...

Make Their Day ~ Often when discussing the 'make their day principle', people complain about being too busy to stop and think about someone else. Keep it simple. Turn an everyday encounter into a pleasant experience for someone. Your kindness, patience and thoughtfulness will be returned.

Be Present ~ With so many demands on our time, we often put 'being present' way down on the list of priorities. This principle means you are focused, listening and even empathising with someone. Not typing or making coffee at the same time.

Choose Your Attitude ~ If you look for negativity you will be sure to find it. Aim to respond to challenges and problems in a constructive and positive way. Where do you invest your energy? Attitudes are contagious. Is yours worth catching?

Access is through referral to, and assessment by, Alfred Health whose staff member goes to the applicant's home to perform the assessment. The respite is provided on Monday to Friday from 10am to 4pm and is staffed by Lifestyle staff and Personal Care Attendants who are qualified to administer medications.
