President's message

Progress continues on our three major objectives:

- **To build a Rosebud-Rye Rotary Warehouse**, which, once paid off will allow a significant increase in the contribution the Club can make to the community. The 55m x 50.5 m block at 26 Henry Wilson Drive was purchased in the first week of August. A "Warehouse Building" Committee will oversee the progress of this project.
- **To support the development of The Wellness Pavilion at Rosebud Secondary College.** The Wellness Pavilion fundraising project will be officially launched on 26 August at 3.30pm. All members have been sent invitations which require a RSVP.
- **To grow our membership.** Membership growth has been the focus of recent activity including a review of our public image—development of new banner, fliers and vests, and guest speakers from clubs with successful recruitment campaigns. Emily Barr who presented on 11th August reminded us of the need to present as a vibrant group which is inclusive to all members regardless of age. Grahame Gordon, President of Frankston Rotary Club which inducted 12 new members in the past 12 months, will be the guest speaker on 8 September.

Reports: Claire Burns reported that 3 of our 4 applicants for the National Youth Service Program were successful. Rosebud-Rye Rotary will sponsor two of the students and Dromana Rotary Club will sponsor one. Thanks to Claire and Neil Stitt for their support of the students in preparing for the interviews and to Claire for participating in the District selection process.

Pat Sansonetti reported on the purchase of a new trailer for transporting the BBQ for sausage sizzles.

The “Ice Forum” which replaced our weekly meeting on 4th August as both informative and concerning.

Stephen Fontana, Assistant Commissioner of Police:

- There has been record number of border seizures of drugs in the past 12 months but this has not seemed to reduce use
- 60% syndicates on crime watch list are involved in illicit drugs
- 70 countries are involved in the production of illicit drugs with Australia being a prime target for selling the drugs because of the inflated prices which are paid here.
- Number of clandestine drug labs in Victoria is increasing
- 75% drugs coming into the country by international mail

Stephen Bright, Peninsula Health advised that abuse of any drugs & alcohol requires a focus on harm reduction for those who become addicted to any substance.

Julie Rae focused on the protective factors which are seen to predispose kids to not become addicted to substance abuse.

- Positive relationships with parents
- Boundaries and structure provided by parents
- Positive school environment & community connectedness.
