Guest Speakers: Both our Guest Speakers gave us much food for thought and provoked numerous questions & discussion.

Caroline Ling, Audiologist, who practices in Rye, spoke to us of noise hazards which can affect our hearing. These include at work, such as using loud machinery or noisy vehicles; at leisure, such as shooting or listening to MP3 players at high volume through earbuds, playing in a band, and attending loud concerts; & at home, such as use of lawnmowers, leaf blowers & woodworking tools.

Claire suggested that more should be done to educate young children about potential hazards, outcomes & preventative measures. Caroline advised that she would look into this. Take home message: Prevention is better than cure.
