Emilie was welcomed to Rosebud-Rye Rotary and presented an overview of her home and family.

Emilie's hometown in Norway is Hamar, the largest city in Hedmark county. It is a modern, busy administrative and commercial centre situated on Lake Mjosa and has a population of 25,000. Hamar is the principal city of Hedmark county with a history recorded as far back as 500 AD. The old town, Domkirkeodden, is partly hidden underground. As well as the Hedmark Museum and historic farmhouses, the remains of a medieval church is housed in a protective glass house at Domkirkeodden.

Emilie, her parents and younger brother, spend summer holidays in a cabin by the lake enjoying barbeques and late nights. Winter holidays are spent at a cabin in the mountains engaging in cross-country and downhill skiing.

Norway has more than a thousand fjords, the most popular and frequently visited being Geirangerfjorden. Norway is also known for its spectacular mountains and wilderness and the Aurora Borealis-the Northern lights –which are caused by collisions between gaseous particles in the Earth's atmosphere.



Ben Hodgetts was our guest speaker this week. Ben spoke of his experience delivering First Aid training in remote areas, specifically in villages in Cambodia where the population is still suffering the effects of the decimation of their numbers in the 1970's, especially of those who were educated. Ben and his companions purchased bikes in Vietnam and transported medical supplies and training kits across to Cambodia, leaving the bikes for use by villagers after completing a series of training. All equipment, including the bikes, were donated or purchased with donations.

The 30th August, being the 5th Tuesday of the month, saw members, families and visitors at the Rosebud R.S.L. for a social evening organized by **Judy Phelan**. The food was good and the conversation incessant so it seems that everyone enjoyed themselves.
