Our guest speaker

The history of Vinnies Kitchen was outlined by President Gil Muling at the meeting on October 25.

Gil said Vinnies Kitchen was founded in 1992 by Christina Thielking, and not long after he joined. "Due to hard work by volunteers over four years we kept it going". "Our charter was to serve free meals to the unemployed, homeless and disadvantaged."

Vinnies provided a warm welcome and social contact, "for many their only contact within the community". "We also assist with specialised help by referring them to relevant organisations."

Clients could sit down and get to know people over a three course meal served in the Rosebud Band Hall, three dinners and two lunches a week. Selected students at Rosebud Secondary College are also served a hot lunch once a week. Vinnies had to date provided 123,461 meals.

Gil said that in the late 90s Parks Victoria took over the Foreshore and wanted to destroy the hall, but a public protest was organised in 2000. After many weeks of negotiation it was agreed that the hall, used by many organisations would not be demolished.

Parks did the rewiring but would not renovate the hall which, built in the 60s, was "a real mess". "There was an urgent need to modernise the kitchen." In 2004 funds were received and conditions were improved.

Vinnies Kitchen is run entirely by volunteers with food donations made by church groups and businesses. Meals used to be prepared at Rosebud Secondary College during school holidays, but for 18 months meals have been provided by Karingal.

Gil said a Christmas party was held then the kitchen was closed December and January.

He said the greatest poverty was loneliness and the best way to beat it was with a hot meal.

Where: The Church Hall, 23 Police Road, Mulgrave

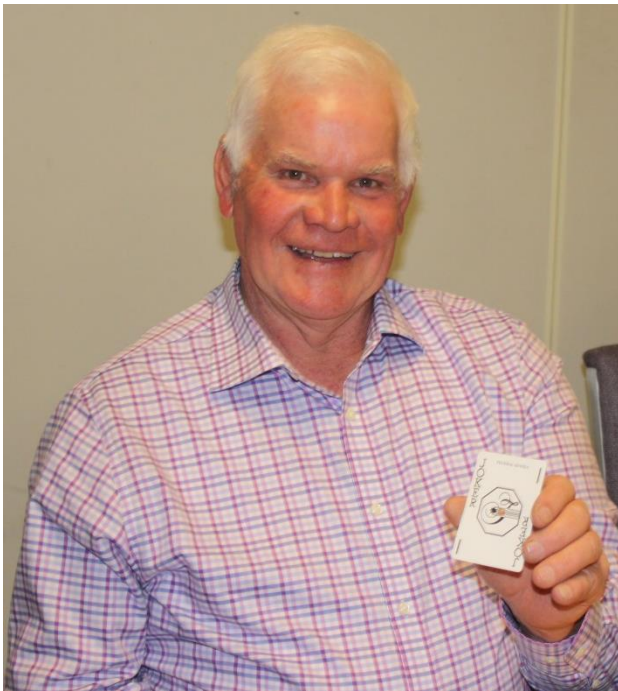
